



Dr Kirstie Bertram is a post-doctoral scientist at Centre for Virus Research, The Westmead Institute for Medical Research. Dr Bertram completed her PhD with Prof. Tony Cunningham and Dr Min Kim on antigen presentation of Herpes Simplex Virus. Since completing her PhD, she has worked as a post-doctoral scientist for Assoc. Prof Andrew Harman where they have specialised in isolating and investigating immune cells in the human mucosal tissues the HIV and HSV interact with, particularly myeloid cells. Their immunological work has expanded into studying immune cells from many skin, type I and II mucosal tissues. Recently she has published HIV and HSV studies in Nature Communications and PLOS pathogens. Work is currently underway is expanding on HIV interacting with inflamed myeloid cell subsets as well as understanding migration of epidermal dendritic cells within human anogenital tissues.
